

Authorship Policy

Every manuscript and/or abstract that is sent out under the auspices of PrimaryPlus must have a GME faculty member in good standing as a co-author. This faculty need not be the corresponding or first author, however, the faculty author should have the credentials and be in a position to take responsibility for the scientific, procedural (e.g., IRB) methodological, etc. soundness of the submission.

It is the responsibility and duty of the program director to make this requirement known to residents/fellow and GME faculty alike.

This policy should be reviewed and documented at regular intervals along with other GME and program policies. The program director should monitor compliance with this policy during portfolio review at semi-annual evaluations. Any resident/fellow who fails to follow this policy shall be subject to the full range of disciplinary options available to the program director from verbal warning, letter of focused improvement, probation and termination for severe or repeated violations.
