

GMEC Policy

The Graduate Medical Education Committee is a standing committee of PrimaryPlus. The GMEC is responsible for the oversight and administration of the ACGME-accredited programs and ensuring compliance with the ACGME Institutional, Common and specialty-subspecialty specific Program Requirements. All residency and fellowship programs at PrimaryPlus are overseen by the GMEC. Voting members of the GMEC include the DIO, program director(s), two peer selected resident/fellows, one program coordinator, one medical director and a Quality Improvement officer from PrimaryPlus.

Responsibilities of the GMEC to maintain oversight of training programs include the following:

Oversight of the accreditation status of the Sponsoring Institution and its ACGME-accredited programs.

Review all applications for ACGME accreditation of new programs and subspecialties.

Changes in resident complement.

Major changes in program structure or length of training.

Additions or deletions of training sites.

Appointments of new program directors.

Progress reports requested by any Review Committee including responses to proposed adverse actions.

Requests for exceptions of resident duty hours.

Requests to inactivate or reactivate a training program.

Voluntary withdrawals of ACGME-accredited programs.

Maintain oversight of the quality of the working environment of the programs and its participating sites.

Assure quality educational experiences that lead to measurable educational outcomes identified in the Common and specialty/subspecialty specific Program Requirements.

Develop and review policies and procedures that affect ACGME-accredited training programs and their trainees.
